Re: CPSIA Compliance

Dear Customer:

JVC America, Inc. is committed to compliance with the Consumer Product Safety Improvement Act of 2008 (CPSIA). Effective immediately, JVC will include relevant information and instructions on our packing slips, invoices, purchase orders and our external website (www.jvc-america.com) in order to meet CPSIA requirements and to serve as a resource to our customers and suppliers.

CPSIA requirements limit the amount of lead in products manufactured and/or distributed by manufactures and packagers of optical media. The CPSIA further requires that each shipment of goods be accompanied by a general certificate of conformity. By rule of the US Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC), this requirement can be satisfied by having a general conformity certificate available on our external website. JVC will include the following statement on its packing slips, invoices and purchase orders: "CPSIA compliance information and requirements for customers and suppliers and General Conformity Certificates pursuant to the CPSIA are available at http:www.jvc-america.com."

Additionally, JVC would like to inform our customers that recent third party test results confirm that our products do not exceed any lead, lead paint and phthalate limits as set forth by the CPSIA. JVC products are in compliance with all requirements of the CPSIA including those scheduled to go into effect in August 2009 and September 2011. JVC will continue to monitor our products periodically to insure ongoing compliance with the CPSIA and other applicable laws.

JVC America, Inc. assumes the responsibility of certifying products it manufactures and components sourced by JVC. JVC must insure that all components distributed with our products meet CPSIA compliance requirements. It is the responsibility of the customer to determine if any components supplied to JVC are subject to CPSIA regulations. Conformity Certificates should be provided to JVC for all relevant items and third-party testing data should be available upon request. Orders will not be processed by JVC if CPSIA regulations are not fully met. JVC reserves the right to request third-party test data for any items provided by the customer that is considered as a children's product or toy as defined by CPSIA.
